June 10, 2018 – Genesis 3:21

“The Lord God made garments (Tunics) of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them.”

Do you enjoy doing laundry?

Just think, if Adam and Eve had not fallen into sin there would be no dirty laundry.

Every time that we wash our clothes, it is a reminder of sin which entered into the world when Adam and Eve desired to be like God, and then ate of the fruit of the tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil.

Satan (who was once a good angel but rebelled against God) tricked Adam & Eve into disobeying God.

The Lord God quickly remedied their shame by the shedding of animal blood to cover the shame of their nakedness and to provide skin coverings.

However, the tunic which covered their bodies did not wash away their sin.

The only shedding of blood that could wash away their sin, that could take away their guilt was, and is the blood of the Lamb of God, Who has taken away the sin of the world by the blood of Jesus, the Christ.

Following are some passages in which we see that we have been clothed in Christ’s Righteousness and by His Holiness. Our guilt is taken away, our sin atoned for by Jesus.

Revelation 7:9 – *“After this I looked and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and in front of the Lamb. They were wearing **white robes** and were holding palm branches in their hands.”*

Rev. 7:13-14 – *“Then One of the elders asked me, these in white robes, who are they and where did they come from? 14 – I answered - SIR, you know. And he said, These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have **washed their robes** and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.”*

Galatians 3:26-27 – *“You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, 27 – for all of you who were baptized into Christ have **clothed** yourselves with Christ.”*

Luke 15:22 – *“The Parable of the Lost Son: 22 – “But the Father said to His servants, Quick! Bring the **BEST ROBE** and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. 23 – Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let us have a feast and celebrate. 24 – For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found. So they began to celebrate.”*

Romans 4:6-8 – *“David says the same thing when he speaks of the blessedness of the man to whom GOD CREDITS RIGHTEOUSNESS apart from works; 7 – Blessed are they whose transgressions are forgiven, whose SINS ARE **COVERED**. Blessed is the man whose sin the Lord will never count against him.” AMEN*
