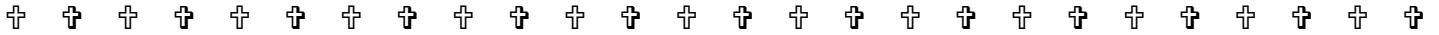


For Worship at Home on Maundy Thursday – 2020



Invocation: In the Name of The Triune God – Father – Son & Holy Spirit. AMEN

Prayer: O Lord God, You have brought us / me safely to this time of worship. I / We thank You for providing all that I / we need for body and life. Forgive my / our sins. Speak to my / our heart. Dispel my / our sorrows with the comfort of Your Word, and receive my / our thanks and praise, through Jesus Christ, my / our living Savior, Who reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, One God, now and forever. The Lord Jesus graciously has given the believers of the New Testament the Sacrament of The Lord’s Supper / Holy Communion.

A Sacrament =

1. A Sacred Act;
2. Instituted / given by Christ;
3. For the Forgiveness of Sins;
4. Has an earthly element connected with The Word of God.

Read: Matthew 26:26-30 – In these verses taken from the Gospel of Matthew, The Lord Jesus makes it very clear what blessings believers receive from God in the Lord’s Supper.

Read: I Corinthians 11:17-34 – In these verses the Lord God, through the Apostle Paul gives us further information on what it is that we eat and drink in the Lord’s Supper.

The Nicene Creed:

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, Very God of Very God, Begotten, not made, Being of one substance with the Father, By Whom all things were made; Who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven And was incarnate by the Holy Ghost of the Virgin Mary, And was made man; And was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried; And the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures; And ascended into heaven, And sitteth on the right hand of the Father; And He shall come again with glory to judge both the quick and the dead; Whose kingdom shall have no end.

And I believe in the Holy Ghost, The Lord and Giver of Life, Who proceedeth from the Father and the Son, Who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, Who spake by the Prophets. And I believe one Holy Christian and Apostolic Church I acknowledge One Baptism for the remission of sins, And I look for the resurrection of the dead, and the Life of the world to come. Amen.
